

## ALL-DAY SUN AND ORIGINAL 19TH CENTURY DETAILS IN THIS HARSIMUS COVE TOWNHOUSE

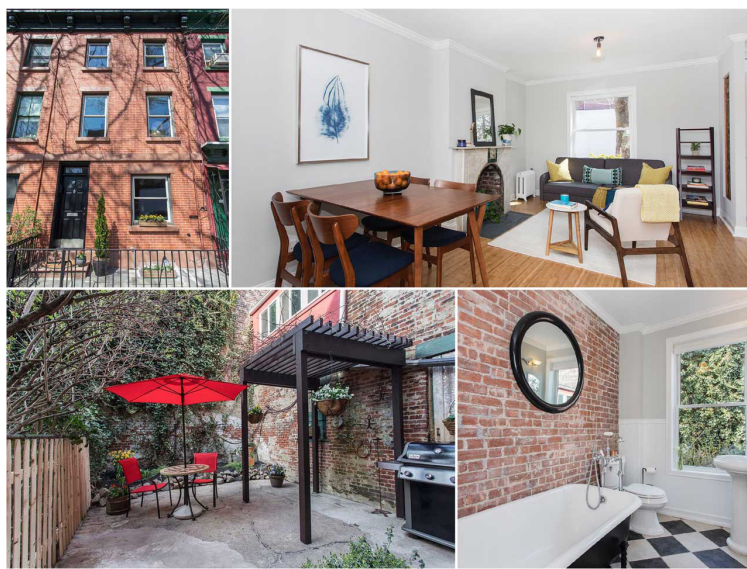
In Jersey City, you can live in a historic neighborhood—or live in one of the homes that make it historic. This three-story, single-family brick townhouse in Harsimus Cove checks both boxes, giving you a prime location in the heart of Jersey City, five minutes from Hamilton Park and six from the Grove Street PATH station.

Because here, history isn't just around your home. It is your home. Originally constructed in the 19th century, 230-½ Fourth Street's period details remain intact. So you'll find clawfoot tubs in two bathrooms, wainscoting, exposed brick and beams, tin ceilings, original hardwood floors, two decorative fireplaces with original marble mantels, and a winding staircase with the original mahogany banister.

Museum-quality details meet modern conveniences inside this three-bedroom, two-bath home. The parlor level's open floor plan offers ample living and dining space and an open kitchen with granite countertops and stainless steel appliances like a 36" six-burner gas range and a washer/dryer by Bosch. From the kitchen, you can access a landscaped outdoor garden with an ivy-covered wall and pergola. You can also enjoy the sun from inside the home, thanks to a southern exposure that provides all-day natural light.

On the second and third floors, you'll find a second living room, along with three bedrooms that boast large closets, as well as another washer/dryer and two full baths.

This historic home at 230-½ Fourth Street sells for \$1,185,000.
